 The default setting is to allow all content to be viewed and downloaded from the Google Play store. Select one of the options to restrict what content can be viewed and downloaded. To figure out what each app is rated as, see "Step 9."

- To see what rating an app has: Click on an app and look under the app name. There will be a rating of Everyone (E), Everyone 10+ (E10), Teen (T), Mature 17+(M) or Adults only 18+ (A).
 - a. In this case, in order to restrict the viewing and downloading of this app, choose the Everyone 10+ option from "Step 8."
 - Setting up restrictions based on content rating only applies to apps that are not currently on the device.
